What are workers' compensation benefits:

- In the state of Illinois a worker can obtain workers' compensation benefits when an on the job accident leads to permanent injury or even the loss of life. At Salgado Injury Law, we work alongside our clients and their families to provide access to the maximum level of workers' compensation benefits. These benefits include:
 - Compensation for lost wages;
 - o Payment of 100% of related and necessary medical care; and

- Please note that a workers' legal immigration status is NOT required to qualify for workers' compensation benefits. In Illinois, everyone who has suffered an accident in the workplace has the legal right to apply for and receive workers' compensation benefits. This is true, regardless of their current legal status. The right to workers' compensation benefits is tied to your rights as a worker and not one's immigration status.

What to do if you have been injured at work?

- 1. Seek immediate medical attention
- 2. Do not forget to tell your preferred medical provider your injuries are related to an accident at work
- 3. Inform the employer of the accident as soon as possible and no later than 45 days from the date of accident
